

Influenced by the Southern California lifestyle and infused with a hint of Japanese sensibility, Lunada Bay Tile designs and produces handcrafted glass, ceramic, and concrete tiles with an emphasis on simplicity, texture, and color.

In 2002, founder and President Carl Steadly launched the company as an importer of slate and a designer of pewter tiles, marketing under the name Stone & Pewter Accents. Shortly thereafter, he developed a glass tile series that took inspiration from painting, prints, sculpture and textiles. Over the years, our product lines expanded from glass into ceramic and concrete. Due to rapidly evolving product lines and growth opportunities, we needed a name that could take us into the future with innovative new designs and materials.

In 2014, the company rebranded as Lunada Bay Tile to better reflect the diversity of products and to create a unified presence. The name honors our history. Lunada Bay, located on the beautiful Palos Verdes Peninsula of Los Angeles, inspires our design philosophy – to blend traditional craftsmanship with modern influences while exploring the boundaries of material possibilities. We take cues from nature, such as Lunada Bay, along with architecture, art and design, to create unique tiles.

After several years of extraordinary growth, our headquarters relocated to a new 100,000 squarefoot facility in Harbor City, California. Our warehouses in California and New Jersey stock more than two million square-feet of material, supporting more than 500 dealers and multiple private-line partners. We employee 100 people within the U.S.

Lunada Bay Tile continues to push the boundaries of tile design, helping people to express their artistic visions on vertical and horizontal planes in residences, commercial spaces and beyond.
